LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ♦ useful things obtained from animals

TEACHING AIDS

Pictures/charts/models/animations on domestic animals: domestic animals doing different works; food and other items obtained from animals (all as given in chapter).

LESSON PLAN

- ♦ Teacher will start the chapter with 'Gear Up' section by discussing the usefulness of animals to us.
- ♦ Now, with the help of teaching aids, teacher will define domestic animals, their living places and why we keep them with us.
- ♦ Teacher will explain the different kinds of works domestic animals do for us.
- ♦ Teacher will also discuss our duties towards domestic animals.
- ♦ Now, to evaluate the learning of students about studied topics, teacher will ask them to solve 'Check Point 1'.
- ♦ Now, with the help of teaching aids, teacher will discuss the food and useful things obtained from animals.
- ♦ Now, teacher will ask students to solve 'Check Point 2'.
- ♦ At last, teacher will sum up the lesson by going through the points given under the head 'Wrap up now'.
- Teacher will help students to answer the questions given under the head 'Practice Time'.

BOOST UP

- ♦ Teacher may encourage students to explore more items of everyday life obtained from animals.
- ♦ Teacher should tell students to be kind towards animals.
