Plant Reproduction

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- process of sexual reproduction in plants
- ways of seed dispersal
- vegetative reproduction

Teaching Aids

Pictures/charts/models/animation on the topics given in the chapter.

Lesson Plan

- Teacher will start the chapter with 'Gear Up' section and help students in doing the task given in the section.
- Now, with the help of suitable teaching aids, teacher will define reproduction.
- Teacher will explain the reproductive organs of plants.
- Teacher will define the sexual reproduction and explain the process of sexual reproduction in plants.
- To check the understanding of students about the topic, teacher will ask them to solve 'Check Point 1'.
- Now, teacher will discuss the seed dispersal, its need and agents of seed dispersal.
- Teacher will define seed germination, conditions necessary for seed germination and process of seed germination.
- Now, teacher will ask students to solve 'Check Point 2'.
- Teacher will define vegetative reproduction and explain its different ways in plants.
- Now, teacher will ask students to solve 'Check Point 3'.
- At last, teacher will sum up the chapter by going through all the points given under the head 'Wrap up now' and revising the 'New Words'.
- Finally, teacher will help students to solve all the exercises given under the head 'Practice Time'.

Boost Up

- Teacher should help students in carrying out activities given in the chapter.
- Teacher should encourage students to explore more ways of seed dispersal in plants.
- Teacher should encourage students to explore more examples of plants showing vegetative reproduction.
