### Lesson Outcomes

- » Create drawings using all the tools learnt.
- » Save a drawing.
- » Open a saved drawing.
- » Open a new drawing.
- » Exit the Paint program.

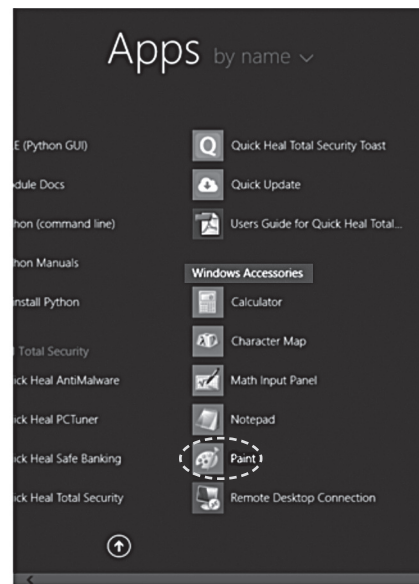

## CHAPTER NOTES

- » MS Paint is a drawing program which is packaged with the Windows OS.
- » To open Paint, click on Windows key → Down-arrow key → Window Accessories → Paint.
- » Identify parts of the Paint window.
- » Quick Access Toolbar contains commonly used shortcuts.
- » Title bar contains the file name and window control buttons.
- » There are two tabs, the Home tab and the View tab. Each tab has its Ribbon.
- » Ribbons are divided into groups. Each group has shortcuts.
- » The Toolbox contains tools like Brush, Eraser, Line, etc.
- » The Shapes box contains ready-made shapes like Heart, Star, Oval, etc.
- » Color box contains 16 different colours.
- » The Color 1 and Color 2 buttons are used as foreground and background colours. To select a colour, press its button.
- » Brushes are of different types which can be selected with a click.
- » Fill colours are of different types which can be selected with a click.
- » Eraser is used to erase a drawing.
- » Click on File → New to open a new drawing.
- » Click on File → Save to save a drawing.
- » Click on File → Open to open a saved drawing.
- » Click on File → Exit to exit from Paint.

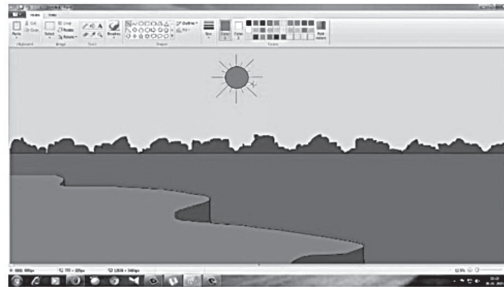
## DEMONSTRATION

- » Open Paint.
- » Select Color 1 and Color 2.

- » Draw freehand with the Pencil or Brushes tool.
- » Use the Eraser tool to erase.
- » Click and create shapes.
- » Use the Fill with color tool to fill shapes with colours.
- » Create different drawings.
- » Create, save and open a file.
