CHAPTER NOTES

- » HOME command brings the turtle back to its starting position. It also draws a line while moving to its home.
- » CLEARSCREEN or CS command erases the drawing and clears the drawing area. It also brings the turtle to its Home position.
- » CLEAN command, like CS, erases the drawing but the turtle remains in the last position where you finished your drawing.
- » CLEARTEXT (CT) command erases all typed text from the Input Box which is also displayed in Recall List Box.
- » To hide the turtle after drawing, simply type HIDETURTLE or HT and press the Enter key from the keyboard.
- » To bring the turtle back on the screen after using HT, type SHOWTURTLE or ST and press Enter. The turtle appears on the screen.
- » PENUP command is used to move the turtle without drawing a line.
- » PENDOWN command is used to move the turtle with a line.
- » PENERASE command is used to erase a line.
- » PPT command is used to stop the eraser.
- » SHOW command prints the input given in the square brackets.
- » LOWERCASE command with SHOW command, converts the text typed in capital (Uppercase) letters into small (Lowercase) letters.
- » UPPERCASE command with the SHOW command converts the text typed in small (lowercase) letters into capital (uppercase) letters.
- » COUNT command gives the total number of characters in the typed text.
- » To display the current date and time on your computer system, type the SHOW TIME command.


