LESSON PLAN

The students will learn about † adaptation adaptations in animals living in different climates

TEACHING AIDS

Pictures/charts/models/animations on locations of deserts, polar areas and rainforests on the world map; adaptations in camel, polar bear, penguin and elephant; migratory birds; arboreal habits in monkey; red-eyed frog; feeding habit of toucan; camouflaging animals; lion-tailed macaque, etc.

LESSON PLAN

- ♦ Teacher will start the chapter by going through the points given in 'Know these points before you start' section.
- ♦ Teacher will define the term adaptation, its types and importance of adaptation to animals.
- ♦ With the help of different teaching aids, teacher will explain adaptations found in animals living in different climates, i.e., camel in desert, polar bear and penguin in polar region and animals living in rainforest and tropical forests (as given in the chapter).
- ♦ Now, teacher will ask students to solve Check Points 1 and 2.
- ♦ Teacher will make students revise the new terms given under the head 'Know These Terms'.
- ♦ Finally, teacher will help students to solve the questions given in exercises under the head 'Practice Time' and 'Think Zone'.

BOOST UP

- Teacher should discuss the information given under the head 'Something More'.
- ♦ Teacher should discuss the conversation of Annu and Mannu given in between the topics.
- ♦ Teacher should encourage students to watch Discovery, National Geographic and Animal Planet channels to know more about plants and animals.
