LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students learn about

- the shape of the Earth
- the globes
- the plains
- the hills

TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper containing pictures of globes, plains, hills, etc., flashcards, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- The teacher will start with 'Warm Up'.
- Then, he/she will explain the shape of the Earth and the globe.
- The teacher, then, will explain the shape of land on the Earth.
- Then, he/she will explain about plains and hills.

BOOST UP

- The teacher may use flashcards to show different land shapes.
- He/She may show a globe to the students.
- Then, the teacher may ask the students to solve the exercises given in the lesson.
- The teacher should explain the pictures given in HOTS.
- The teacher should initiate a discussion on the topic given in Value Corner.
