# My Family

### **LESSON PLAN**

#### **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

The students will learn about

- O the family, i.e., what a family is
- O different types of family

#### TEACHING AIDS

Photographs, charts, a blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

#### TEACHING STRATEGY

- O First, the teacher will ask the students (one-by-one) to recite the rhyme given in Warm Up. The rhyme introduces the members of a family.
- O Then, the teacher will explain what a family is.
- O The teacher, then, will describe different types of family—small family, big family and joint family.
- O He/She should tell the students the merits and demerits of a big family.

#### BOOST UP

- O To make the lesson interactive, the teacher may ask the students about their family/family members.
- O The teacher may show photographs of the family of different famous persons.
- O The teacher should explain the topic given in Knowledge Zone.
- O The teacher should initiate a discussion on the topic given in HOTS and Life Skills.
- O The teacher will ask the students to solve the exercises given in the book to evaluate them.

#### EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn

- O what a family is
- O different types of family

The teacher may ask the following questions to the students to evaluate them.

- 1. What do you mean by family?
- **2.** What types of family are there?
