LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students

- learn about schools
- learn about different rooms in a school
- learn about different activities done in a school
- learn to keep their school neat and clean

TEACHING AIDS

Charts having pictures of different rooms and activities of a school, posters, blackboard, chalk, duster, projector, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- The teacher will start with the Warm Up. The exercise will give the students an idea about what a school is.
- The teacher, then, will explain the function of a school with practical examples.
- The teacher will tell about the different rooms that are there in a school. He/She may take the students to these rooms to give them a first-hand experience.
- The teacher will advise the students to be obedient and to keep the school neat and clean.

BOOST UP

- The teacher may show photographs or tell about such schools which are historically important, i.e., established by any social reformer or any freedom fighter, etc.
- The teacher may tell about some glorious moments of the school they belong to.
- The teacher may ask the students to recite the following rhyme:

I am Ready

I'm ready to be a grade older.

I'm ready to ride the bus.

I'm ready to meet my teacher.

I'm ready to use these pencils.

I'm ready to make new friends.

- The teacher will ask the students solve the exercises. These will help him/her understand the progress of the students.
- The teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in the HOTS. He/She may give some hints to the students.
- The teacher will explain the idea given in the Value Corner and the Life Skills.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to

- know about schools
- know the importance of going to school
- know different rooms/departments of a school
- know the importance of keeping the school clean and beautiful
- become more obedient
