# **LESSON PLAN**

# **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

- O Learning how presence of mind enables one to overcome problems
- O Reading, listening and understanding the lesson
- O Answering the questions orally and in writing
- O Vocabulary—Words, meanings, spellings, pronunciation
- O Grammar—Prepositions and their usage
- O Learning to converse

#### WARM UP

- O Help the students to do 'Warm Up' exercise.
- O Tell that wolf, fox, jackal belong to the same family.
- O Presence of mind can help us to overcome any problem.

Outcome: One should keep a calm mind while in difficulty

## READING

- O Read the lesson aloud and ask the students to read in turns.
- O Correct their pronunciation, explain the lesson.
- O Ask questions like, "Is wolf a dangerous animal?" "How pet animals are useful?"

*Outcome:* Reading aloud, listening attentively, learning new words, meanings, spellings, pronunciation.

### READ AND UNDERSTAND

- O Exercise A: Discuss each question with options. Let the students mark correct options in their books.
- O Discuss Exercises B and C. Let them do Exercises B and C. The teacher will write the answers on the blackboard. Students will transcribe them in their notebooks.

Outcome: Understanding and answering the questions orally and in writing.

### GRAMMAR IS FUN

- O Explain what prepositions are by using the blackboard and examples given.
- O Discuss Exercise D. Give answers orally. The students will circle the correct prepositions in the book.

*Outcome:* Prepositions and their usage.

# LET'S SPELL

- O Ask the students to fill in the missing letters in the blanks to get the right words.
- O Announce the answers so that the students can correct each other's work in pairs.

Outcome: Correct spellings, meanings and pronunciation.

#### WORD POWER

O Ask the students to see the pictures and by recognising them fill in the missing letters.

*Outcome:* Learning names of musical instruments.

#### LET'S LISTEN

- O Read the story twice.
- O Then discuss the questions and ask the students to answers them orally.

Outcome: Listening, understanding and answering the questions.

# LET'S SPEAK

- $\circ$  Read aloud the words in each column. Specify the clear pronunciation of the |z| sound.
- O Specify the words in the second column that are spelt either with a 'g' or a 'j'. They are pronounced dʒ. Ask the students to read each word aloud.

*Outcome:* Differentiating between |3| and |d3| sounds.

### LET'S CONVERSE

- O Let two students enact the role of Anita and Sunita.
- O The teacher can correct the pronunciation, pauses, inflexions, etc.

Outcome: Learning how to converse, pronounce, pause, express correctly.

### WRITING SKILLS

- O Discuss the riddles in the class. Let the students then, fill in the blanks on their own.
- O Correct answers can be announced by the teacher and the students can check on their own.

*Outcome:* Learning to use words and understanding their use in riddles.

# **ACTIVITY/PROJECT**

O Let the students colour the dog. Tell them about some of the famous breeds of dogs.

*Outcome:* Expressing one's creativity.
