

At the Toy Shop

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- O Understanding the role of toys in our lives.
- OReading, listening and understanding the lesson
- | OAnswering questions orally and in writing
- OVocabulary—Words, meanings, spellings, pronunciation
- OGrammar—Use of 'ing' words
- OLearning to converse

WARM UP

- O Help the students name the toys given in Warm Up.
- O Discuss how toys are useful.
- O Tell the students that they should not play with dangerous toys.

Outcome: Knowing about toys and their utility.

READING

- O Read the lesson aloud. Students can read a few lines, each in rotation.
- OCorrect the pronunciation, pauses, etc.
- O Ask the students about their favourite toys.

Outcome: Reading aloud, listening attentively, pronunciation, spellings, etc.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- OLet the students do Exercise A on their own.
- ODiscuss Exercises B and C. The students can answer orally. Write the correct answers on the blackboard.

Outcome: Understanding and answering questions orally and in writing.

GRAMMAR IS FUN

- OExplain how verbs are made by using '-ing'. What do they show—actions that are going at the time of speaking.
- OLet the students do Exercise D on their own.

Outcome: Verbs made by adding '-ing'.

LET'S SPELL

- OAsk the students to select the correct word from the given box and fill in the blanks.
- OCorrect answers can be announced by the teacher and the students can correct in their books.

Outcome: Learning spellings, meanings and usage.

WORD POWER

ODiscuss Exercise F and the students will mark correct answers in their books. The teacher can give some more names of toys to be completed by the students.

Outcome: Learning the names of toys.

LET'S LISTEN

- ORead the passage twice. Ask the students to listen attentively.
- O Then ask them the questions.
- OCorrect their mistakes and pronunciation.

Outcome: Listening attentively and answering questions orally.

LET'S SPEAK

ORead aloud the words. Show how words are pronounced differently even if they begin with the same letters.

Outcome: Learning how to pronounce words.

LET'S CONVERSE

- OSelect two students as Raghav and Anmol.
- OAsk them to enact the conversation in the class.
- OCorrect their pronunciation, emphasis, pauses, etc.

Outcome: Listening carefully and speaking correctly, pronunciation, spellings, etc.

WRITING SKILLS

ODiscuss what can be filled in the blanks. Then write the words on the board and let the students copy them.

Outcome: Learning to write neatly and correctly.

ACTIVITY/PROJECT

OLet the students paste pictures of their favourite toys on their own.

OHelp them to fill in the blanks.

Outcome: Expressing one's creativity.
