

If I Could be an Astronaut

LESSON PLAN

In this poem, the poet Bobbi Katz tells us what he would to like to do when he becomes an astronaut. He visualises the funny things he would find on the planet he visits.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- O Enjoying poetry and understanding it.
- ONote how the poet visualises fish with feathers, trees that can walk, etc.
- \ OAnswering the questions on the poem.

READING

- O Read the poem aloud—correctly articulating the words, rhythm, mood and pauses.
- OExplain the poem to the students.
- OAsk them to name the planets of the solar system.
- OLet the students recite the poem in groups.

Outcome: Enjoying and learning to recite and understand the poem–rhythm, rhyme, modulation of voice.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- OLet the students do Exercise A on their own. Announce the answers.
- ODiscuss each question and answer of Exercise B. Write the correct answers on the blackboard and the students can transcribe them in their books.

Outcome: Answering the questions orally and in writing.

ACTIVITY PROJECT

OTell the names of the astronauts and the students will transcribe in their books.

Outcome: Recognising famous Indian astronauts.
