# SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES Reading, enjoying and reciting poetry. Understanding the poem Understanding and answering questions on it.

#### READING

- O Read the poem aloud with correct pronunciation and rhythm. Students may recite in four groups.
- O Explain the poem.

Outcome: Read, recite and understand.

#### READ AND UNDERSTAND

- O Let the students do Exercise A on their own.
- O Announce the correct answers so that the students can check and correct their answers.
- O Discuss Exercises B and C. As the correct answer emerges, dictate it. The students can write it down neatly in their notebooks.

Outcome: Answering questions on the poem.

### **ACTIVITY/PROJECT**

O Let the students do this activity on their own.
