LESSON PLAN

_	SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES
О	Learning about zoo—what it is, the type of animals that are kept there
OListening, reading and understanding the lesson	
O.A	Answering the questions orally and in writing
$V_{\rm C}$	ocabulary—Words, meanings, spellings, pronunciation
OGrammar—Making words using '-ing'	
OL	earning to converse

WARM UP

- O Help the students do the activity given in the Warm Up.
- O Ask questions like, "Why are animals kept in cages?" "Why should we not give food items to zoo animals?"
- O Tell the students about the way they should behave at the zoo.

Outcome: Learning about zoo, the animals in it, the name of our national bird.

<u>READING</u>

- O Read the lesson aloud and ask the students to take turns in reading aloud. Correct their pronunciation.
- OTalk about difference between wild and domestic animals.
- O Tell the students that they should be kind to animals.

Outcome: Reading aloud, understanding words, meanings, spellings and pronunciation.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- OLet the students do Exercise A on their own.
- ODiscuss Exercises B and C. Let the students answer orally. Then the teacher should write each answer on the blackboard and let the students transcribe them in their notebooks.

Outcome: Reading, understanding and answering the questions orally and in writing.

GRAMMAR IS FUN

- OExplain how verbs are made by using 'ed' words. They tell about actions that took place in the past.
- ODiscuss exercise D and let the students do on their own.

Outcome: Verbs made by adding '-ed'

LET'S SPELL

OAsk the students to select the correct word from the given box and fill in the blanks with letters.

Outcome: Learning spellings, meanings and pronunciation.

WORD POWER

OHelp the students to find out the names of animals in the grid.

Outcome: Sorting out names from a grid.

LET'S LISTEN

- ORead the passage twice. Ask the students to listen to it carefully.
- OThen ask them the questions one at a time and correct their answers and pronunciation.

Outcome: Listening attentively and answering the questions orally.

LET'S SPEAK

- ORead each column of words aloud, ensuring correct pronunciation.
- OTeach clear distinction between |u| and |u:|

Outcome: Differentiating between | v | and | u: | sounds.

LET'S CONVERSE

- OLet two students enact the conversation in the class.
- OCorrect their pronunciation, emphasis, pauses, intonation, etc.

Outcome: Learning to converse.

WRITING SKILLS

ODiscuss the exercise with the class. The students can easily make sentences on elephant with the help of hints given in the Help Box.

Outcome: Enhancement of writing skills.

ACTIVITY/PROJECT

OLet the students name different animals given in the animix. You can assist them in naming the correct animal.

Outcome: Expressing one's creativity.
