LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- O Enjoying the rhyme and rhythm of poetry.
- OLearning recitation with correct pronunciation and pauses.

- OAnswering questions on the poem.

READING

- O Read the poem aloud, making it a fun moment, showing the actions of chimpanzee and penguins.
- OAsk the students to learn the poem and recite in a group.
- OExplain the meaning of 'trembling'.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

ODiscuss Exercises A and B. The students mark the correct answers in their books.

Outcome: Answering the questions orally and in writing.

ACTIVITY/PROJECT

OTell about the names of some domestic and wild animals. Let the students do the exercise on their own.
