## LESSON PLAN

This poem tells us how we should behave while at the zoo.

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Enjoying the rhyme and rhythm of poetry.
- Learning recitation with correct pronunciation and pauses.
- Understanding the poem.
- Answering questions on the poem.

### READING

- Read the poem aloud, making it a fun moment, showing the actions of chimpanzee and penguins.
- Ask the students to learn the poem and recite in a group.
- Explain the meaning of 'trembling'.

### READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Discuss Exercises A and B. The students mark the correct answers in their books.

**Outcome:** Answering the questions orally and in writing.

### ACTIVITY/PROJECT

- Tell about the names of some domestic and wild animals. Let the students do the exercise on their own.

**Outcome:** Expressing one's analytical ability.
