LESSON PLAN

This is a poem written by Robert Louis Stevenson. It tells about the joy one feels while riding a swing.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES Reading, enjoying and reciting the poem Understanding the poem Answering questions on it

READ AND ENJOY

- O Read the poem aloud in the class with correct rhythm and pronunciation.
- O Ask the students whether they enjoy going up and down on a swing.
- O Students can learn and recite the poem. Correct them wherever required.

Outcome: Recite and enjoy poetry.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- O The students will do Exercise A on their own.
- O Discuss Exercise B.

ACTIVITY/PROJECT

O The students are familiar with these objects. They often see them in a park.

Outcome: Enhancement of observation power.
