

# I Keep Six Honest Men

## LESSON PLAN

This famous poem of Rudyard Kipling tells us how we can gain knowledge. If we have curiosity, we will use words like what, why, etc., to gain knowledge.

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Reading, enjoying and reciting poetry.
- Understanding the poem
- Understanding and answering questions on it.

### READING

- Read the poem aloud with correct pronunciation and rhythm.
- Students to follow.
- Explain the poem.

*Outcome:* Read, recite and understand.

### READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Let the students do Exercises A and B on their own.
- Announce the correct answers so that the students can check and correct their answers.
- Discuss Exercise C. As the correct answer emerges, dictate it. The students can write it down neatly in their notebooks.
- Students can do Exercise D on their own. The teacher can announce the answer in the class.

*Outcome:* Answering questions on the poem.

### ACTIVITY/PROJECT

- Make groups in the class and act as moderator in the discussion.

*Outcome:* Enhancement of knowledge.
