LESSON PLAN

This famous poem of Rudyard Kipling tells us how we can gain knowledge. If we have curiosity, we will use words like what, why, etc., to gain knowledge.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- O Reading, enjoying and reciting poetry.
- O Understanding the poem
- Understanding and answering questions on it.

READING

- O Read the poem aloud with correct pronunciation and rhythm.
- O Students to follow.
- O Explain the poem.

Outcome: Read, recite and understand.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- O Let the students do Exercises A and B on their own.
- O Announce the correct answers so that the students can check and correct their answers.
- O Discuss Exercise C. As the correct answer emerges, dictate it. The students can write it down neatly in their notebooks.
- O Students can do Exercise D on their own. The teacher can announce the answer in the class.

Outcome: Answering questions on the poem.

ACTIVITY/PROJECT

O Make groups in the class and act as moderator in the discussion.

Outcome: Enhancement of knowledge.
