

The Lion and the Mouse

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

Learning about consideration to others, sharing and being friendly

- O Reading, listening and understanding the lesson
- O Answering questions orally and in writing
- O Speaking correctly and clearly
- O Vocabulary—Words, meanings, spellings, pronunciation
 - O Grammar—Describing words: how they are used to describe nouns
- O Learning to converse

WARM UP

- O Discuss pictures: Tell the students that the lion is a very strong animal.
- O Discuss why it is necessary to be kind. What happens if we are selfish and unkind?

Outcome: Helping others is a good thing.

READING

- O Read aloud the lesson slowly, allowing students to follow.
- O Explain the lesson.
- O Ask the students if they like picture stories and comics. Why?

Outcome: Reading aloud, listening attentively, learning word meanings, spellings and pronunciation

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- O Let the students do exercise A on their own.
- O Discuss exercises B and C.
- O Ask them the answers.

O They can write answers in their books.

Outcome: Answering the questions.

GRAMMAR IS FUN

- O Explain what describing words are using blackboard, examples from book, class, school, home, etc.
- O Exercise D: Do orally in class and let the students underline the adjectives. Ask them which word is described.

Outcome: Adjectives and their usage.

LET'S SPELL

- O Ask students to fill in the blanks after selecting the right word.
- O Corrections to be read aloud by the teacher and to be carried out by the students themselves.

Outcome: Spelling of words, pronunciation and meaning.

WORD POWER

O Discuss the exercise and the students will mark correct answers in the books.

Outcome: Learning the names of homes of animals.

LET'S LISTEN

- O Read the passage twice.
- O Discuss the questions and their answers. Encourage students to answer the questions.

Outcome: Listening attentively, answering the questions orally.

LET'S SPEAK

O Read each pair of words, differentiating the sounds of |z| and $|d_3|$

Outcome: Differentiate pronunciation of words |z| and $|d_3|$

LET'S CONVERSE

- O Select two students. Let them read out the dialogues.
- O Correct their pronunciation and speech.

Outcome: Learning to converse, pronunciation, emphasis, pauses, inflexions

WRITING SKILLS

O Ask students to make sentences using each word orally. Write the correct ones on the blackboard. Students will transcribe in their notebooks.

Outcome: Learning to use suitable words in sentences.

ACTIVITY/PROJECT

O Let the students select and paste pictures in the space given. You can help them to name the animals.

Outcome: Learning how to sort out pictures.
