LESSON PLAN

This motivational poem tells us how a little kite is afraid to fly but later on it tries and is successful in reaching very high sky.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES Reading, enjoying and reciting poetry Understanding the poem—it tells that if we try again and again, we can succeed Understanding and answering questions on it

READING

- Read the poem aloud with correct pronunciation and rhythm. Students may recite in four groups.
- O Explain the poem and its words and phrases, e.g., thrilled with pride, tranquil sky, etc.

Outcome: Read, recite and understand.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- O Let the students do Exercise A on their own. Announce the correct answers so that the students can check their answers.
- O Discuss Exercise B. Discuss one question at a time. As the correct answer emerges, dictate it for students to write it down neatly in their books/notebooks.

Outcome: Answering questions on the poem.

ACTIVITY PROJECT

- O Make groups of two students each. Let each group do Exercise C. Guide them as regards to pronunciation, expression, etc.
- O Exercise D: Make a specimen of the letter first. Let the students fill in the blanks.

Outcome: Expressing one's creativity.
