# Fun at the Park



## **LESSON PLAN**

#### **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

- · Learning that recreation is as important as studying
- Playing keeps us healthy and fit
- Recognising things in a park
- Vocabulary—Words, meanings, spellings, pronunciation
- Grammar—Verbs and their usage
- · Learning to converse

#### WARM UP

- Ask the students the games they like to play.
- Talk to them about the benefits of playing outdoors.

Outcome: Playing in a park is a good form of recreation.

## READ AND ENJOY

- Read aloud the lesson and ask the students to read in turns.
- Correct their pronunciation.
- Explain the lesson.

**Outcome:** Reading aloud, listening attentively, learning new words, spellings, pronunciation.

## READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Exercise A: Discuss each question with options. Let the students mark the correct options in the book.
- Let the students do Exercises B and C on their own in the class. Correct them if they are wrong.

**Outcome:** Understanding and answering the questions.

# GRAMMAR IS FUN

- Explain what verbs are using the blackboard and examples from classroom, school and home.
- Exercises D and E can be done orally in the class. The students can write answers in their notebooks.
- 16 Beads 1 Term 1 (English)

**Outcome:** Learning about verbs and their usage.

## LET'S SPELL

Ask students to select word from the given box and fill in the blanks with letters.

**Outcome:** Recalling words in the lesson, learning to spell.

#### WORD POWER

- Explain what opposite words are. Encourage the students to find the opposites.
- Let the students match the things with their names.

Outcome: Learning opposites and matching things with their names.

### LET'S LISTEN

 Ask the students to listen to the passage carefully. Ask questions one at a time and ask the students to answer them orally.

**Outcome:** Listening attentively, understanding and answering the questions orally.

#### LET'S SPEAK

• Read the given words aloud, carefully differentiating the sound |æ| and |x:|

**Outcome:** Learning the difference in pronouncing |x| and |x|

# LET'S CONVERSE

- Let two students enact the conversation. Correct their pronunciation.
- Correct the pronunciation, pauses, inflexions, etc.

Outcome: Learning how to talk, pronounce, pause, etc.

# WRITING SKILLS

Discuss the possible words that can be added to complete each sentence.

**Outcome:** Using suitable words to make complete sentences.

# ACTIVITY/PROJECT

Encourage the students to do colouring without anybody's help.

Outcome: Expressing individual creativity.
