CHAPTER NOTES

- » MS Word is a text editor application by Microsoft and is a part of the Microsoft Office suite.
- » We can create amazing documents with the help of MS Word and make them appear even more wonderful.
- » The process of making changes in the text is called Editing.
- » Inserting text means adding missing text anywhere in typed text.
- » Moving text means changing the position of selected text from one place to another. This feature is also called Cut and Paste.
- » When we use the Cut command, text is removed or erased from the original location and is sent to the Clipboard. On using the Paste command, the cut text is pasted there.
- » The Copy command will just copy the selected text from its original place and create a duplicate copy of it at the new location without deleting the text from its original location.
- » While editing a document, you come across a situation when you want to search a particular word in your document and replace it with another word. To do so, you can use the Find and Replace feature.
