

# Parallels and Meridians

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## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- parallels
- meridians
- locating places on the globe

### TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, a projector, models, flashcards, globes, maps, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, ask the students to do the exercise in Warm Up.
- Tell about parallels in detail.
- Tell about meridians in detail.
- Tell how to locate places on the globe.

### BOOST UP

- The teacher will show globes, maps, models, etc.
- The teacher will ask the students to solve the exercises in the lesson.
- The teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.
