LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, a projector, models, flashcards, globes, maps, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, start with Warm Up.
