

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- evergreen forests
- location and extent of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (The DRC)
- physical features of the DRC
- climate conditions of the DRC
- natural vegetation and wildlife of the DRC
- economic activities in the DRC
- life of the people in the DRC

TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, a projector, models, flashcards, globes, maps, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- Start with Warm Up.
- Tell about the evergreen forests.
- Tell about the location and extent of the DRC.
- Tell about the physical features of the DRC.
- Tell about the climatic conditions of the DRC.
- Tell about the natural vegetation and wildlife of the DRC.
- Tell about the economic activities of the DRC.
- The teacher, then, will tell about life of people living in the DRC.

BOOST UP

- The teacher may show chart papers.
- The teacher may show flashcards.
- The teacher may show photographs of the region.
- The teacher, then, will ask the students to do the exercises given in the lesson.
- Then, the teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.
- The teacher may also initiate a discussion on the topic given in Value Corner.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students will be able to understand about

- evergreen forests
- location and extent of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (The DRC)
- physical features of the DRC
- climate of the DRC
- natural vegetation and wildlife of the DRC
- economic activities in the DRC
- life of the people in the DRC

The teacher may ask the following questions to evaluate the students.

- 3. Write a brief note on the wildlife of the DRC.
