## **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

## **READ AND DISCOVER**

- Read aloud the poem and enjoy it.
- Explain it, its words and humour.
- Ask the students to learn and recite it.
- Correct their pronunciation, pauses, rhythm and voice modulation.

**Outcome:** Enjoying poetry, reciting correctly; understanding humour.

## **READ AND UNDERSTAND**

- Exercise A: Discuss the answers of the questions and let the students mark them in their books.
- Exercise B: Ask the students to colour the picture.

**Outcome:** Answering the questions; seeing the picture and colouring it.
