- > Learning to enjoy humour.
- > Answering the questions on the poem.

## Reading

- \* Read the poem aloud with correct pronunciation and rhythm.
- \* Explain the poem.
- \* Ask the students if they like mice.

Outcome: Learning recitation, word meanings and pronunciation.

Read and understand

\* Discuss Exercises A and B. The students can mark the answers in their books.

Outcome: Understanding the poem and answering questions on it.

## Activity/Project

\* Let the students colour Mickey Mouse. You can tell them Mickey Mouse was created by Walt Disney.

Outcome: Expressing one's creativity.
