SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- > Enjoying poetry and understanding it.
- > Learning to enjoy humour.
- > Answering the questions on the poem.

Reading

- * Read the poem aloud with correct pronunciation and rhythm.
- * Explain the poem.
- * Ask the students if they like mice.

Outcome: Learning recitation, word meanings and pronunciation.

Read and understand

* Discuss Exercises A and B. The students can mark the answers in their books.

Outcome: Understanding the poem and answering questions on it.

Activity/Project

* Let the students colour Mickey Mouse. You can tell them Mickey Mouse was created by Walt Disney.

Outcome: Expressing one's creativity.
