



## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

### READING

- Explain the phrases.

**Outcome:** Read, recite and understand.

### READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Let the students do Exercises A and B on their own. Announce the correct answers so that the students can check and correct their answers.
- Discuss the questions of Exercise C.
- As the correct answer emerges, dictate it for the students to write neatly in their books.

**Outcome:** Answering questions on the poem.

### ACTIVITY/PROJECT

- Encourage the students to speak in front of the class.

**Outcome:** Learning the art of speaking in public.
