LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Enjoying poetry and understanding it.
- Learning to enjoy humour.
- Answering the questions on the poem.

READ AND ENJOY

- Read the poem aloud with correct pronunciation and rhythm.
- Explain the poem.
- Ask the students if they like mice.

Outcome: Learning recitation, word meanings and pronunciation.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Discuss Exercises A and B. The students can mark the answers in their books.

Outcome: Understanding the poem and answering questions on it.

ACTIVITY/PROJECT

- Let the students colour Mickey Mouse. You can tell them Mickey Mouse was created by Walt Disney.

Outcome: Expressing one's creativity.
