LESSON PLAN

This is a delightfully funny poem by Christine F. Fletcher. It tells you not to get friendly with a crocodile because it is a dangerous animal and it should not be treated like a friendly little puppy.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Enjoying poetry, understanding it, recitation
- Learning to enjoy humour
- Answering the questions on the poem

READING

- Read aloud the poem and enjoy it.
- Explain it, its words and its humour.
- Ask the students to learn and recite it.
- Correct their pronunciation, pauses, rhythm and voice modulation.

Outcome: Enjoying poetry, reciting correctly; understanding humour.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Exercise A: Discuss the answers and let the students mark them in their books.
- Exercise B: Ask the students to colour the picture.

Outcome: Answering the questions; seeing the picture and colouring it
