- Announce the correct answers so that the students can check and correct their answers.
- Discuss Exercise C. As the correct answer emerges, dictate it. The students can write down the answers neatly in their notebooks.

Outcome: Answering questions on the poem.

ACTIVITY/PROJECT

- Let the students do this activity on their own.
