LESSON PLAN

This poem tells young children how to conduct their life. In other words, it tells how to become a gentleman. If the children follow the precepts given in the poem, they will be liked by one and all.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Reading, enjoying and reciting poetry
- Understanding the poem and answering questions on it

READ AND ENJOY

- Read the poem aloud with correct pronunciation and rhythm.
- Explain words and phrases like, 'do not loiter', 'often want a loaf to taste', 'daintiest' etc.

Outcome: Read, recite and understand.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Let the students do Exercise A on their own.
- Announce the correct answers so that the students can check and correct their answers.
- Discuss questions of Exercises B and C. As the correct answers emerge, write them on the blackboard. The students can then transcribe the answers in their notebooks.

Outcome: Answering questions on the poem.

ACTIVITY/PROJECT

- Help the students in doing Exercises D and E.

Outcome: Learning things that are beneficial to us.
