## **LESSON PLAN**

#### **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

- Reading, enjoying and reciting poetry
- Understanding the poem—it is about belief in oneself
- Understanding and answering questions on it

### READ AND ENJOY

- Read the poem aloud.
- Ask the students to learn and recite it.
- Correct them wherever required.

Outcome: Recite and enjoy poetry.

### READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Exercise A can be done by the students on their own.
- Discuss Exercise B. When the correct answer emerges, write it on the blackboard or dictate it in the class. Students can write the correct answers in their notebooks.

**Outcome:** Answering questions on the poem.
