LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Reading, enjoying and reciting poetry.
- Understanding the poem—it is about spreading happiness.
- Understanding and answering questions on it.

READ AND ENJOY

- Read the poem aloud with proper expressions.
- Ask the students to learn and recite as a class.

Outcome: Recite, enjoy poem and understand it.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Let the students do Exercises A and B on their own.
- Announce the correct answers. Let the students correct their answers. Assess the sentences made by the students.
- Discuss each question of Exercise C. Dictate the correct answers. Students can write them down.

Outcome: Understanding and answering questions on the poem.

ACTIVITY PROJECT

- Let the students do this exercise on their own.

Outcome: Enhancement of writing skills.
