## Lesson Plan

This poem tells us how we should behave while at the zoo.

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- › Enjoying the rhyme and rhythm of poetry
- › Learning recitation with correct pronunciation and pauses
- › Understanding the poem
- › Answering questions on the poem

## Reading

- \* Read the poem aloud, making it a fun moment, showing the actions of chimpanzee and penguins.
- \* Ask the students to learn the poem and recite in a group.
- \* Explain the meaning of 'Strutting'.

## Read and Understand

- \* Discuss Exercises A and B. The students mark the correct answers in their books.

**Outcome:** Answering the questions orally and in writing.

## Activity/Project

- \* Tell about the names of some domestic and wild animals. Let the students do the exercise on their own.

**Outcome:** Expressing one's analytical ability.
