#### Reading

- \* Read the poem aloud, making it a fun moment, showing the actions of chimpanzee and penguins.
- \* Ask the students to learn the poem and recite in a group.
- \* Explain the meaning of 'Strutting'.

### Read and Understand

\* Discuss Exercises A and B. The students mark the correct answers in their books.

Outcome: Answering the questions orally and in writing.

#### Activity/Project

\* Tell about the names of some domestic and wild animals. Let the students do the exercise on their own.
