SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- **>** Enjoying poetry, understanding it, recitation.
- > Learning to enjoy humour.
- **>** Answering the questions on the poem.

Read and Enjoy

- * Read aloud the poem.
- * Explain its humour.
- * Ask the students to learn and recite it.
- * Correct their pronunciation, pauses, rhythm, etc.

Outcome: Enjoying poetry, reciting correctly, understanding humour.

Read and Understand

- * Let the students do Exercise A on their own. Announce the answers and let the students correct their answers.
- * Exercise B: Discuss in the class. The students can mark the correct answers in their books.

Outcome: Answering the questions orally and in writing.

Activity/Project

st You can make five groups in the class. Ask each group to name a vegetarian and non-vegetarian animal.

Outcome: Enhancement of deductive reasoning.
