LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- The students will learn about
- O globes
- O maps
- O oceans
- O continents
- O directions

TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, globes, maps, a blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, the teacher will start with Warm Up.
- The teacher, then, will explain about globes and maps.
- The teacher, then, will explain about oceans and continents.
- The teacher, then, will explain about directions and Mariner's compass.

BOOST UP

- To make the lesson interesting, the teacher may use globes, maps, models, etc.
- The teacher may show a compass and may explain its function.
- The teacher will ask the students to solve the exercises to evaluate them.
- The teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in HOTS.
