LESSON PLAN

- SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- O what manufacturing is
- o what industry is
- O cottage industry, small-scale industry and large-scale industry
- o industrial belts

TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, flashcards, a projector, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- O Start with Warm Up.
- O Tell what manufacturing is.
- O Tell what an industry is.
- O Tell about cottage industry, small-scale industry and large-scale industry.

BOOST UP

- O The teacher may show charts.
- O The teacher may show thematic maps of India.
- O The teacher may show different mineral ores.
- O Then, the teacher will ask the students to solve the exercises. Guide them wherever required.
- O Then, the teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic in HOTS.
