TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, a projector, models, flashcards, globes, maps, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- O Start with Warm Up.
- O Tell about the Evergreen forests.
- O Tell about the location and extent of the DRC.
- O Tell about the physical features of the DRC.
- O Tell about the climatic conditions of the DRC.
- O Tell about the natural vegetation and wildlife of the DRC.
- O Tell about the economic activities of the DRC.
- O The teacher, then, will tell about life of people living in the DRC.

BOOST UP

- O The teacher may show chart paper.
- O The teacher may show flashcards.
- O The teacher may show photographs of the region.

- O The teacher, then, will ask the students to do the exercises given in the lesson.
- O Then, the teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic in HOTS.
- The teacher may also initiate a discussion on the topic given in Life Skills.
