## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- what a constitution is
- the Fundamental Rights
- our Fundamental Duties
- Directive Principles

### TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, flashcards, a projector, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- Start with Warm Up.
- Tell what a constitution is.
- Tell about the Preamble in the Constitution.
- Tell about the Fundamental Rights.
- Tell about the Fundamental Duties.
- Tell about the Directive Principles.

### BOOST UP

- The teacher may show chart papers.
- The teacher should explain the Preamble in our Constitution.
- The teacher will ask the students to solve the exercises.
- The teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic in HOTS.
- The teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic in Value Corner.
