C	Exercise A: Ask the students to look at the pictures and try to find out the names of the trees.	Get Set!
Э	They can use the internet to know the names of the trees.	
C	Exercise B: In the class, discuss the value of mistakes that we make in our daily lives and what we learn from them.	
C	Understanding that one should not feel embarrassed of making mistakes because they help us learn and grow.	
Э	Read the lesson aloud so that students are able to hear you clearly.	<b>Read and Enjoy</b>
C	Explain the words and meanings. Reading creates familiarisation with words.	
C	Talk about animal life and how all animals live together in a jungle and be friends with each other.	
Э	Focus on the central idea of the story - Believing things easily without checking the facts can be a waste of time and energy and cause embarrassment too.	
C	Discuss the questions in Exercises A, B, C and D and ask the students to answer orally first.	Read and Understand
C	Where necessary, write the answers on the board to help them in answering questions on the text, whether oral or written.	
Э	Use the board to explain determiners - their relation to different words and how they include words that may be a different part of speech but the usage makes them determiners.	Grammar Spotlight

	Э	Explain in detail the three articles – a, an and the. Clarify their usage.
	Э	Explain by using the given examples and also your own, and ask students to think of examples too.
	C	Exercises A, B and C may be done orally first. Then ask the students to write the right answers. Announce the answers aloud and have the partners check them.
Spell Well	Э	Getting to know new words.
•	Э	Exercise A: Learn to recognise the new words by selecting and completing them.
	Э	Learn their spellings and meanings.
	Э	Brush up on the use of the dictionary if required.
	0	After doing Exercise A orally first, ask the students to write down the answers.
Word Power	Э	Learning about words with suffixes and phrases.
	0	Exercise A: Read this with the students and as you give examples of each suffix, you can add your own examples, or ask the students to suggest them.
	C	It is advisable to make sentences orally when explaining suffixes. Also ensure that correct pronunciation is learnt.
	Э	Exercise B: First ask the students to orally select the right phrase.
	C	Then, as the correct answers come up, they may write down the phrases in their notebooks.
	0	It is desirable to practise more sentences orally using phrases in common use. Examples: take off; go ahead; open up; cool down; shake up; make do; etc.
Listen and Learn	C	Listen to the accent, stress and intonation in the Digital Content so that you can guide the students accordingly.
	C	The teacher can read aloud the questions and ask the students to answer them.
	Э	When the correct answers are received, write them down on the board.
	0	Check the students where necessary as they answer the questions orally.
Converse and Connect	C	Read the conversation aloud and make sure the students have understood it.
	Э	Then ask pairs of students at random to enact the dialogue.
	Э	Correct the students regarding content and pronunciation.
Speak and Express	Э	Read and explain the question to the students.
	C	Relate to the lesson: How did Chikoo clear his confusion? What did he learn from his experience?
	C	Ask the students to speak up their mind.
	C	This will help them to express themselves frankly.
	C	Teach them to put their thoughts into words correctly and politely.
	0	Teach them how to speak so as to be understood.
Dremunsistier	0	This will help them to be observant and to speak out their minds freely.
Pronunciation Practice	3	Let the students listen to the Digital Content so that they are sure of the right way to say the words.

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Э	Let the students say aloud all the words.	
C	While explaining the correct pronunciation, show how these words are pronounced distinctly.	
Э	Ensure that the students learn the phonetic symbols also.	
C	Exercise A: Explain the question to the students so that they understand it clearly.	Write Well
Э	Then let them write the diary entry on their own.	
Э	Check their work individually.	
Э	Ask them to look up the words in the dictionary.	<b>Dictionary Skills</b>
Э	They can write down the meanings in the notebook.	
Э	Note that some words have more than one meaning.	
С	Ask the students to follow the steps given to make a hanging star.	Project Work/AIL
Э	They can perform this activity with their partners.	Activity
Э	If time permits, ask them to say a few in sentences about their display.
