LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Enjoying poetry and understanding it
- Reading and reciting the poem correctly with rhythm and correct emphasis
- Answering the questions on the poem

➤ Read aloud the poem once through, keeping in mind its rhythm and rhyme. Then read it line by line, explaining words, phrases and ideas. Like – taken for granted; I've been blessed; nurtured; taught us with care; you were always there; the special place; each sacrifice of love; carry in your hearts, etc. Explain using possible day-to-day examples from the lives of the students – chores at home, appreciating the work and sacrifices of their parents, etc.	Read and Enjoy
➤ A & B: The exercises can be done by the students on their own. Their work should be checked individually.	Read and Understand
➤ A. Ask the students to answer the question orally and then write down the correct answers in their books.	Word Power
➤ Explain what 'hyperbole' is – the exaggeration of a fact to increase its effect or to emphasise the point. Use the given examples and explain. Examples – a storm of tears; a golden opportunity; rich as Midas; etc.	Appreciating the Poem
