Appreciating the Poem	♦	Ask the students to give you suggestions about rhyming words. Write them down on the blackboard.
Think and Answer	\$	Exercise A: Ask the students to write the answer. Check and assess their work individually.
Word Wise	*	Exercise A: Explain the exercise and do it orally first, and then ask the students to mark in the work grid. Announce the answers aloud and let them check their work in pairs.
Write Well	*	Explain the exercise and let the students express freely their thoughts.
AIL Activity	\$	The students will write the poem on chart papers. Check if they have spelt the words correctly.
