## India–Our Motherland

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about India in detail.

<b>Teaching Aids</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ Chart papers, flashcards, a projector, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.</li> </ul>												
<b>Teaching Strategy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ Start with Warm Up. Ask the students to tick (✓) the correct map.</li> <li>✧ Tell about India's location on the world map.</li> <li>✧ Tell about the physical features of India in brief.</li> <li>✧ Tell about the states and union territories of India.</li> </ul>												
<b>Boost UP</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ To make the lesson more interesting, the teacher may use chart papers.</li> <li>✧ The teacher may show a political and a physical map of India to the students.</li> <li>✧ The teacher may show a world map to show the location of India on the world map.</li> <li>✧ The teacher will ask the students to solve the exercises given in the lesson.</li> <li>✧ The teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in HOTS.</li> </ul>
