The students will learn about Mumbai in detail.

<b>Teaching Aids</b>	✧ Chart papers, flashcards, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.
<b>Teaching Strategy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ First, the teacher will start with Warm Up. The exercise will introduce Mumbai to the students.</li> <li>✧ Tell about Mumbai—the Financial Capital of India.</li> <li>✧ Tell about the climate of Mumbai.</li> <li>✧ Tell about Mumbai Municipal Corporation.</li> <li>✧ Tell about the festivals of Mumbai.</li> <li>✧ Tell about Bollywood.</li> <li>✧ Tell about beaches and monuments in Mumbai.</li> </ul>
<b>Boost UP</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✧ The teacher may use a political map of Mumbai to show the location of different places.</li> <li>✧ The teacher may show flashcards of different monuments.</li> <li>✧ The teacher may show pictures of monorail.</li> <li>✧ Ask the students to solve the exercises.</li> <li>✧ Initiate a discussion on the topic given in HOTS.</li> </ul>
