Tutankhamun was an Egyptian pharaoh of the 18th dynasty during the period of Egyptian history called the New Kingdom. He was popularly called 'King Tut'. His original name was Tutankhaten which means 'Living Image of Aten'. But Tutankhamun means 'Living Image of Amun'. In 1922, Tutankhamun's intact tomb was discovered by Howard Carter and George Herbert. This discovery generated a lot of public interest worldwide due to its press coverage and a new interest in ancient Egypt was sparked. Tutankhamun's burial mask is kept at Cairo Museum.

Tutankhamun was the son of Akhenaten. As a prince he was called Tutankhaten and ascended the throne in 1333 BC at the age of nine or ten. He married Ankhesenpaaten when he became king and they had two daughters, both stillborn. In the third year of his rule be brought about many changes. He ended the worship of the God Aten and restored the supremacy of the God Amun. The capital was moved back to Thebes and the city of Akhetaten was abandoned. This is the time when he changed his name to 'Tutankhamen'. Many monuments were built in his reign and he established good relations with other kingdoms. He died at the young age of nineteen and his mummy is kept in his tomb in the valley of kings. Some say he was assassinated while others believe that he died due to some illness.
