It is difficult to point one society or country for the invention of the candle. The first candles may have been melting lumps of animal fat set on fire.

Archaelogical evidence indicates that both the Egyptians and the Greeks in 3000 B.C.E. were probably using candles that had wicks. Many ancient cultures seem to have developed same variation of the candle. They used materials like beeswax, tallow or even the product of berries to make the wax. This surrounded a wick which was made of plant material, rolled papyrus or rolled rice paper.

Burning with a flame, candle remained useful for producing controlled artificial light for years. Candles were cheap and efficient as well as useful in creating light throughout the Middle Ages and right up to the middle of the nineteenth century when paraffin first became available and could be bought. Then, paraffin lamps began to be used in most homes later.

Nowadays, with the use of gas and electricity, candles are used only on occasions. They create a peaceful and reflective atmosphere in a religious place or in the home. You also get fragrant candles these days in special designs.
